• What is Common App?


The Common App, officially known as the Common Application, is an online platform that allows students to apply to a wide range of colleges and universities with a single application.

• How it works?

Instead of filling out separate applications for each college, students create a single Common App account and complete a core application. They can then select which member colleges they want to apply to and submit the same core application to each, along with any required supplemental materials or essays specific to that institution.

• Who uses it?
